1. **When God gives us an assignment, we always have to make an adjustment.
Exodus 4:19-20**
2. **You cannot stay where you are and go with God at the same time.**
 - Noah could not continue life as usual and also build an ark. Genesis 6
 - Abraham could not remain where he was and also go to the Promised Land. Genesis 12
 - Moses could not stay on the backside of the desert herding sheep and also stand before Pharaoh. Exodus 3:10
3. **Adjusting your life to God can be costly both to you and to those around you.**
 - When Moses obeyed God and told Pharaoh to let Israel go, it proved to be costly to the Israelites. Exodus 5
4. **Adjusting your life to God is always well worth the cost. Exodus 14:30-31**
5. **Adjusting your life to God requires total surrender and complete dependence on Him. Exodus 3:11-12a**
