1. **The Jordan River is a place of identification.**

Jesus through His baptism identified with us. We also must identify ourselves with Him.

2. **The Jordan River is a place of submission.**

Jesus through His baptism demonstrated His submission to the Father. We also must submit ourselves to God.

3. **The Jordan River is a place of faith in action.**

Jesus through His baptism acted on what He thought, felt & believed. We also must be willing to demonstrate what we really think, feel & believe about God.

4. **The Jordan River is a place of confirmation.**

Jesus through His baptism received a confirming word from the Father. We also will receive confirmation from God as we commit ourselves to Him and as we live out our commitments.
